

An 89,000 word domestic suspense novel with a dual-timeline structure, HONEY, I'M HOME by Jenn Crowe follows Pri Tuffin and the story of how her husband has been missing for the last eight years—since the night she dumped his body and told authorities he never returned from a hunting trip, leaving her a single mother of twins. It was the only way to escape him after uncovering his involvement in the disappearance of multiple women. But she can never let anyone discover what she did if she wants to maintain her picture-perfect life as one of Denver's most successful real estate agents.

When her husband, Marcus, shows up on her doorstep alive and claiming to have no memory of the past eight years, Pri's world begins to fracture. Their children are thrilled, the police are suspicious, and everyone in the neighborhood is watching. Is he who he says he is? Where has he been? And, most terrifying of all, how much does he remember?

Sinister incidents escalate, and the cracks in Pri's carefully constructed life split wide open. First, it's a dead bird on her deck. Then, her son lands in the hospital. Fearing for the safety of her family, Pri suspects Marcus has a plan for revenge, and she becomes determined to find the proof that will expose him before he can strike again. But as she races to stay one step ahead of him, it seems one wrong move could endanger everyone she loves. And the more she uncovers, the more she realizes the real enemy may not be the man she thought she buried in her past, but the truth she never saw coming.

Fast-paced and filled with twists, HONEY, I'M HOME will appeal to readers of Lisa Jewell, Gillian McAllister, and Robyn Harding, and will ask one chilling question: what happens when the life you rebuilt is threatened by the husband you thought was dead?
